Adoption of Bill 122 "A historic turning point for the municipal sector! " Ota Hora, Mayor of the Municipality of Kazabazua

Kazabazua, June 19, 2017 - The Mayor of the Municipality of Kazabazua, Mr. Ota Hora, welcomes the passage in the National Assembly of Bill 122, which officially recognizes municipalities as local governments.

« This is a historic turning point, not only for Kazabazua but also for the municipal community as a whole. Finally, the legislature recognizes that municipal councils are responsible and accountable, and that they have the legitimacy to govern. By bringing together citizens' decisions, this law will help build stronger, more prosperous and sustainable communities while fostering greater citizen participation », declared Mister Ota Hora..

In concrete terms, this bill will give more autonomy and powers to the municipality of Kazabazua and the 1,110 other Quebec municipalities in the following areas: land use planning; Economic development, transparency and information for citizens; Taxation and municipal finance; Governance.

« In the end, all of the current and future Kazabazuin will benefit from this new legislative and regulatory framework. I salute the excellent work of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Mr. Martin Coiteux, and the determination of the Prime Minister of Quebec, Mr. Philippe Couillard, who completed the necessary reforms for the municipal sector. Today we can look to the future with optimism, because we finally have a greater capacity to act to meet the needs of our fellow citizens, » concluded the Mayor of Kazabazua.
