WHEREAS the payment is conditional on the Minister's acceptance of accountability for the project;

WHEREAS, if the accountability is found to be in conformity, the Minister shall make a payment to the municipalities on the basis of the list of works he has approved, without exceeding the maximum amount of assistance as it appears in the letter of announcement;

WHEREAS other sources of funding for the work have been declared;

THEREFORE, on the proposal of Craig Gabie, seconded by Matthew Orlando, it is unanimously resolved and adopted

THAT the council of the municipality of Kazabazua approve the expenses in the amount of \$164,497.16 relating to the improvement work and the eligible inherent costs mentioned in Form V-0321, in accordance with the requirements of the Ministère des Transports du Québec, and recognizes that in the event of non-compliance with them, the financial assistance will be terminated.
