WHEREAS this regulation is part of a commitment to ensure that municipalities form firefighting crews which have the skills and abilities necessary to respond effectively to emergency situations;

WHEREAS in December 2014, the Quebec government established the Financial Assistance Program for the training of volunteers or part-time firefighters;

WHEREAS this program's main objective is to provide municipal organizations with financial assistance to enable them to have a sufficient number of qualified firefighters to act effectively and safely in an emergency;

WHEREAS this program also aims to promote the acquisition of competencies and basic skills required by volunteer and part-time firefighters working in municipal fire safety services;

WHEREAS the Municipality of Kazabazua wishes to benefit from the financial support offered by the program;

WHEREAS the Municipality of Kazabazua plans to provide training for 3 volunteer fire fighters during the next year to respond effectively and safely to emergencies in its territory;

WHEREAS the municipality must send the application to the Ministry of Public Security through the MRCVG in accordance with Article 6 of the Program.

2016-01-23 FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION 2016 – KAZABAZUA LAKES ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS the Kazabazua Lake Association represents nine lakes and more than 300 cottagers;

WHEREAS in 2012, the MRC Vallée-de-la-Gatineau published the results of a comprehensive study of its lakes ranked by vulnerability, and that eight of these lakes are listed as moderate to high vulnerability;

WHEREAS, in the study of our region, these checklists ("characterization studies") are performed by the Bassin Versant 7 Association, and that according to their team of biologists, such a study would cost about \$20,000 for all nine lakes or \$11,000 for an initial limited study of Danford Lake and Shea Lake;

WHEREAS in July 2015, members of the Lakes Association approved a maximum expense of \$5,000 for this purpose;

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the Municipality to keep our lakes healthy and that the study will be of great benefit;

THEREFORE IT IS MOVED by Kevin Molyneaux **SECONDED** by Kim Cuddihey-Peck and unanimously resolved,

THAT council supports the study and that a contribution in the amount up to a maximum of \$5,000 be engaged for the project study of our lakes in the municipality and once that report becomes available that a copy be made available to the Municipality,

FURTHERMORE that the contribution comes from the budget account 55-99200-000 accumulated surplus affected for the year 2015.
