**WHEREAS** the Municipality of Kazabazua wishes to benefit from the financial support offered by the program;

**WHEREAS** the Municipality of Kazabazua provides for the formation of two (2) firefighters during the next year to respond effectively and safely in emergency situations on its territory;

**WHEREAS** the municipality must send his application to the Department of Public Safety through the MRC of Vallée-de-la-Gatineau in accordance with Article 6 of the program.
