MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO THE NOMINATION OF A RESPONSIBLE OF THE PREPARATION OF A SINISTER

WHEREAS local municipalities have, under the Civil Security Act (Q.R.A., c. S 2.3), the responsibility for civil security on their territory;

WHEREAS the municipality is exposed to various vagaries of natural and anthropogenic origin that could be the source of disasters;

WHEREAS the Kazabazua Municipal Council recognizes that the municipality can be affected by a disaster at any time;

WHEREAS the Municipal Council sees the importance of preparing for disasters that may occur on its territory;

WHEREAS the Kazabazua Municipal Council wishes to provide the municipality with a preparation to respond to any type of disaster that may occur on its territory;

WHEREAS the disaster preparedness measures that will be put in place will have to be recorded in a civil safety plan;

WHEREAS the implementation of disaster preparedness measures and the development of a civil safety plan require the participation of several municipal services, including fire safety, public works and the administration;

WHEREAS this preparation and that this plan must be maintained operational and be regularly monitored with the Municipal Council.

WHEREAS for this purpose, it is also necessary to establish an intervention protocol that adequately identifies the stakeholders to be contacted in order to avoid any waste of time;

WHEREAS the user fees for this tool are paid in full by the Quebec Automobile Insurance Corporation;

WHEREAS the Municipality of Kazabazua Fire Department has the jaws of life and that its responders are properly trained to use them;

FOR THESE MOTIFS, IT IS PROPOSED by Paul Chamberlain, **SECONDED** by Henri Chamberlain and unanimously resolved;

THAT the municipality of Kazabazua authorizes its fire department to intervene only in the territory of the City of Maniwaki when an event requires the use of the jaws of life:

THAT for jaws of life staff, the billed time is counted from the time they leave the fire hall until all the equipment used is in place for another intervention, including the time of personnel required to clean and set up the equipment.

THAT the jaws of life assistance service is payable following the production of an invoice identifying the expenses incurred, the number of staff assigned and the hours of staff assigned. Interest is applicable on the amounts due at the current rate;

THAT this agreement ends on November 30th, 2019;

TO authorize the Mayor and the Director General to sign any document relating to this request.
